- To participate actively in Board discussions, and contribute to the decision making process at the Board table.
- To keep Board discussions confidential.

## **Requirements for All Directors**

All Board members are required to fulfill the following responsibilities:

- Attend and be prepared for each monthly meeting.
- Read and understand Board Policy.
