Upon families moving into their home, Settlement Services employees will make sure that families receive a welcome bag. We will also teach families how to use any unfamiliar items. Receiving these bags helps welcome newcomers to Prince Albert and teaches them about their new homes!

For the Kitchen:

- Reusable shopping bag (items on the list can fit in these bags)
- Saran wrap
- Aluminum foil
- Ziploc bags – 2 sizes
- Dish cloth(s)
- Tea towel(s)
- Dish sponge or scrubber
- Pot holders
- Paper Towel

Toiletries:

- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Soap
- Deodorants
- Toothbrushes
- Toothpaste
- Small Laundry Detergent
- Kleenex
- Lotion

Cleaning Supplies:

- Rubber gloves
- Kitchen cleaner
- Bathroom cleaner
- Multi-purpose cleaner
- Window and glass cleaner
- Toilet bowl cleaner
- Toilet brush
- Plunger
